Duration of the Electives, Application Deadline	July 7- August 1, 2025 (4 weeks) *Deadline: Thursday, February 6, 2025 *No other sessions can be arranged.
Eligibility	Undergraduate medical students who have passed skills examination for clinical rotations at your institution.
Selection Criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Motivation letter: State clearly why they are interested in the departments for each of your students' top three choices. *Please refer to the link below - a list of departments at Shinshu University School of Medicine. https://www.shinshu-u.ac.jp/faculty/medicine/eng/undergraduate/list.html ▪ Recommendation letter: Written by the dean or equivalent at your institution in English using your letterhead. ▪ Transcript: Your students' academic records issued by your institution.
Application	<p>Your students need to submit the following documents,a)-f), via your institution to the International Relations Office, Shinshu University School of Medicine, by the application deadline for the initial screening:</p> <p>a) Application form (Form 1) b) A letter of motivation d) A copy of passport (personal information) e) A letter of recommendation from the dean or equivalent of your institution f) A transcript of studies (academic records)</p> <p>*Note: Late submission or Incomplete application documents may affect your students' eligibility for the program.</p> <p>Your students need to submit documents, g)&h), after receiving a conditional offer of training.</p> <p>g) Certificate of health for applicants to School of Medicine and University Hospital (Form 2) h) A copy of health and liability insurance certificate (it must cover medical fees and compensation costs claimed during his/her stay in Japan)</p>
Certification	After successful completion of training, your students receive a Certificate of Training.
Fees	Shinshu University does not charge registration or training fees. Personal expenses such as travel, accommodation, and food must be paid by your students or your institution.
Accommodation	Your students will rent privately-owned apartments offered by agencies (approx. 80,000 JPY, including utility costs). The International Relations Office will offer support for arranging their accommodation.
